



Welcome to the Uraidla Netball Club – Season 2022

The Uraidla Netball Club welcomes all new and existing players and parents to the 2022 season. This information pack will assist in communications between club, players and their parents. Due to the current Covid-19 outbreak there is some hesitation within the community to return to activities. The Uraidla Netball Club is mindful of this and continue to do what they can to limit the risk to participants being exposed to the virus by adhering to Netball SA and SA Health recommendations.

Net Set

Uraidla runs a **NetSet** program on Sunday mornings 15/5 to 7/8 (10 weeks). Total cost is \$88.15 which includes netsetgo shirt. This program is for children aged 5 to 7 in 2022 until they are eligible for U9's. There is no uniform required.

NetSetGO is Netball Australia's junior entry netball program. It provides children with a positive introduction to netball, incorporating skill activities, minor games, music, dance and modified matches. Delivered in a fun and safe environment, the weekly program is coordinated by coaches to ensure all participants have an enjoyable experience, while developing fundamental skills. Details about the program will be advertised by the club.

Uniform Information for Season 2022

All uniforms are to be ordered and purchased online direct from the supplier. Orders will be delivered to the club for distribution prior to season commencement.

Cut-off for ordering uniforms is 13th March 2022. Orders placed after this date will not be guaranteed to arrive prior to season commencement on 30th April

This year we have added a single and short combination as an alternative to the A-line dress for game day uniform.



Prices for uniform are:

- **A-line Dress** \$65
- **Boyleg Playing Shorts** \$30
- **Juniors Playing Top** \$40
- **Seniors Warm-up Top** \$40 (includes name on back for no additional charge)
- **Parklands Jacket** \$95 (+ \$5 name embroidered on front)
- **Zip Hoodie** \$50 (+ \$5 name embroidered on front)
- **Sports bag** \$50 (+ \$5 name embroidered)
- **Backpack** \$45 (+ \$5 name embroidered)
- **Socks** \$8.50

Club socks and beanies can be ordered through PlayHQ at the time of registration. Socks are \$8.70 and Beanies \$20.50.

Junior teams from U9 to U11 wear a Club polo top with navy blue netball skirt or shorts and white socks, or club socks with a logo. Juniors can wear any navy-blue skirt, skort or shorts. They do not need to be club specific.

U13's and Inters teams (U15 to U17) wear an A-line dress with bike shorts or navy club shorts and a club playing top and white socks, or club socks with a logo.

Senior teams wear an A-line dress with bike shorts or navy club shorts and a club playing top and white socks, or club socks with a logo.

Registration

Netball is moving to a new registration system in 2022 (PlayHQ). Please note that with the new registration system, players must be registered before team nominations can be submitted, which means the last day for registrations is 20th March 2022.

Please note all 9u players must register for Competition with Hills Netball Association and not with NetSetGO.

Fees

Below is a breakdown of 2022 fees. The fee increases are primarily due to increases in Netball SA fees, inclusion of a Netball Australia fee, and processing fees related to the new PlayHQ system.

Note that the Netball SA fee is a one per player per year fee, so if you play in several competitions you will only pay this once. The club component of fees has increased by \$2 (our first increase for several years) while the HNA component is unchanged.

At our recent AGM, members also supported a motion that juniors playing seniors will pay the same club fee as seniors.

NOTE NetSetGo fees TBC for 2022

The UNC component includes HNA's team registration fee (\$100 per team or approx \$12 per player) as well as all club costs - umpires, balls and equipment, cleaning supplies / basic upkeep, electricity, water filtration, as well as all maintenance and funds towards future upgrades. As we are not council owned, we pay all maintenance and fund upgrades with grant support if available.

All players must pay via the PlayHQ portal by the 20th of March non-financial players may be prevented from taking the court. As a club, we have in the past accepted cash or payments by instalments. With the new system, fees must be paid in full with a credit card at the time of registration. If this is likely to be an issue for you, please contact Club treasurer (Sally Monteleone) before registering. If your family is eligible for the 3 or more family discount, please also contact Sally before registering.

School sports vouchers will still be accepted at the time of registering and in 2022 can also be claimed by students in years 8 and 9. Note that at the moment, the new system cannot 'split' the voucher, which means for 9U players, the discount would only be \$78. If this changes we'll let you know, but otherwise you may wish to consider using the voucher for a different eligible sport. Coaches

All coaches have completed the Foundation Coaching course with Netball Australia as a minimum requirement. New coaches are always welcome. Your coach will contact you prior to the beginning of the season to advise training times and contact details. They will also provide volunteer rosters for the team. Please adhere to these rosters as it allows the coach to focus on the team during the game. Tasks usually include time-keeping, scoring and Captain.

Training

Training days and times will be communicated by the individual coaches. Junior training is usually held at the Uraidla Netball courts. If it is raining, training will usually be held in the shelter shed or the Uraidla Primary School gym which is located adjacent to the oval.

Umpiring

The club is always looking for experienced umpires from U9 to A Grade. Please let us know if you can assist with umpiring this season.

Fundraising/Canteen & Football Club Roster

All players/parents will be rostered to assist in the canteen during the season. The Netball club usually assists with a number of dinners at the Uraidla Football Club during the season. You may be rostered to cook meals, wash dishes or clean the club rooms. The dinners are held on Saturday nights and clean-up is Sunday morning.

Your support of these events is greatly appreciated. We undertake these duties so that the club can share in a portion of the profits on meals for the year.
